Firstly, as above, we are now really looking forward to delving deep into our new *Explore – Water* project. During this project, children will explore the River Ouse, including the features of this local river, where it travels to and from, important landmarks found along the way, jobs related to working with the waterway and the wildlife sustained by its waters. Pupils will also be learning more about rivers abroad, including The Amazon, The Rhine and The Nile. Across the school, students will take part in field work, learning more about how to use directional knowledge and a compass, how to read an OS map, and how to use 4-figure grid references. We are looking forward to getting in to the 'flow' of these exciting lessons!

From the week commencing **Monday 20th January**, we invite all families to join us for our 'class curriculum meetings'. In these meetings, taking place in your child's classroom, teachers will share with parents and carers the class curriculum overview for the *Explore* project (from January to April) and answer any questions and queries you might have about your child's class.

All these class meets will take place at pick-up time when the pupils have been dismissed (3.10pm).
